

NOVA SCOTIA UTILITY AND REVIEW BOARD NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

THE MUNICIPALITY OF THE COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND has made application to the Board under section 368 of the *Municipal Government Act* to reduce the number of councillors and polling districts from 13 to 8 and to set the new boundaries for the polling districts for the municipal election to be held in October 2020. The hearing has been scheduled as follows:
